The colourful lithograph presented here is from the 1967 series of works by Marc Chagall and Charles Sorlier titled "Nice and Côte d'Azur". A beautiful young mermaid with flowing red hair and a colourful bouquet of flowers in her hands floats above the deep blue waters of the Mediterranean. In the background, Chagall details the architecture of the glamorous city of Nice in the moonlight.

The city of Nice played a major role in the work of the painter-poet and inspired him to create numerous maritime depictions. Since 1973, Nice has been home to the Musée National Marc Chagall, which houses a comprehensive collection of the artist's prints, drawings and paintings.
