Alexej von Jawlensky settled in Wiesbaden, Germany, in 1921. It was at that time that he created his first of many abstract heads - also known as "saints' heads". The exclusive painting "Meditation: The Tender Native" from 1935 is one of these unmistakable abstract portraits for which Alexej von Jawlensky became so famous.
