



Pablo Picasso: Picture "Tete de Femme de profil" (1952)

This linoleum cut "Tête de Femme de profile" exemplifies Pablo Picasso's experimental engagement with the print medium of the linoleum cut. From 1959 to 1961, he produced 88 linoleum cuts, often coloured in an earthy brown and beige.

The subject of the feminine face in the profile is a recurring motif in Picasso's oeuvre. With this particular representation - reminiscent of Hellenistic models - he once again makes his partner and muse, Jacqueline Roque, the protagonist of his very own painterly narrative.

Picasso created numerous prints during his artistic career. The few coloured, hand-signed linoleum cuts, especially from low editions, are among the most sought-after and stable collector's items today and are rarely available on the market.
