



Marc Chagall: Picture "Woman with a Bouquet of Flowers" (1967)

This colourful lithograph is part of the series "Nice & Côte d'Azur" by Marc Chagall, published by Charles Sorlier in 1967. At the centre of the image appears an opulent bouquet of flowers that literally seems to burst out at the viewer. A crescent moon envelops the entire scene with its protagonists in a glistening orange light. In the background, Chagall hints at the Bay of Nice.

This glamorous port city on the Côte d'Azur played a prominent role in the work of the painter-poet and inspired him to numerous maritime depictions. Since 1973, Nice has been home to the Musée National Marc Chagall, which houses a comprehensive collection of the artist's prints, drawings and paintings and makes them accessible to the public.
