This etching is part of the cycle of works "Circulation Time" made in 1985, which can be understood as an ode to humans and the animal world. The series was published in collaboration with Grafos Verlag AG, which was based in Vaduz at the time. Joseph Beuys is considered one of the most internationally influential artists of the 20th century and the father of the German Fluxus movement, which negated art and the work in its conventional sense: "Through people, ideas move on, while in works of art, they freeze and eventually remain behind", he formulated in this context.
