

Tony Cragg: Sculpture "Early Forms" (1993)

This plaster sculpture from 1993 is part of the "Early Forms" series. Cragg used the curved lines and bodies of amphorae, test tubes and bottles, which are still partially recognisable, and turned them into animal-like or at least organic-looking structures reminiscent of shells.

Sculpture made of plaster, 1993. With a photo confirmation of the artist, exhibited on 17.03.1994. Height: 33 cm, width: 45 cm, depth: 42 cm.
