On 28 October 1806, Napoleon marched triumphantly into Berlin - the Prussians had been defeated at Jena and Auerstedt. Römer & Römer transport this historical event into the year 2006. Napoleon, in a field-grey coat and the uniform of a colonel of the guard, enters Berlin on his flying horse, accompanied by the fusilier guard armed with muzzle-loaders. The spectators are real contemporaries of today.
