

Pablo Picasso: Picture "Figure Composee I" (1949)

In the style of his early cubist work, Pablo Picasso produced the present signed and numbered lithograph "Figure Composee I". In a typical manner, the facial features of the depicted woman are distorted in perspective and formally broken up.

Picasso created this print at an important time for him: In 1949, he was asked to design the poster for the Peace Congress in Paris. For this, he developed the motif of the dove, which has always been read and reproduced as a symbol of peace.
