

Ernst Ludwig Kirchner: Picture "Sitting Lovers" (around 1910)

Kunsthaus ARTES is very pleased to present a rare drawing by the master of German Expressionism, Ernst Ludwig Kirchner. "I must draw to frenzy, only draw. Just work, work and think of nothing else." - this statement by Kirchner makes it clear how absorbed he was in the artistic activity of drawing.

The work "Sitting Lovers" was created around 1910, an important and eventful period for the artist. In 1911, Kirchner and the members of the artist group "Die Brücke" moved from Dresden to Berlin before they finally split up in 1915. The attractive drawing offered here bears witness to the artist's early, expressive style. He creates a complex, loving scenery with only a few quick strokes.
