In 1959, Andy Warhol collaborated with his friend Suzie Frankfurt to produce a limited-edition cookbook for New York's high society. They called it "Wild Raspberries" inspired by Ingmar Bergman's film "Wild Strawberries", which had just been released in cinemas. It is undoubtedly the funniest and most imaginative cookery book ever produced. Nineteen vintage Warhol illustrations accompany the comical recipes - including Piglet, A&P Surprise, Gefilte of Fighting Fish, Seared Roebuck and Baked Hawaii - conceptualised by Suzie Frankfurt and hand-lettered by Mrs Julia Warhola, Andy's mother.
