

Heinz Mack:

Picture "Untitled, Net Grid (The Diligence of Bees)" (1968) (Unique piece)

Early on, Heinz Mack emphasized his working method on formal elements such as vibrations, oscillations or serial structures: "I think that lines condense into an energy field, a structure in which all parts, all elements stand in an indissoluble connection to each other and begin to vibrate or even oscillate if we observe them with sensitivity and calmness".

In the unique piece offered here, Heinz Mack presents us with a net-like or honeycomb-like structure in black on white ground. Through his unique technique and the partially condensing ink lines, the artist creates a work rich in contrast, which seems to move due to the dark and light areas. The lines appear delicate but, at the same time, full of intensity and power.
