



Günther Uecker: Picture "Walking the Circle - Ouroboros, Motif 6" (2018)

Günther Uecker recently made the series of terragraphics entitled "Walking the Circle - Ouroboros". The special feature of a terragraph is that sand is added to the paint during the screen-printing process. The work cycle "Ouroboros" refers to the archaic pictorial motif of a snake biting its own tail, and so its body forms a closed circle. The symbol, which originates from ancient Egyptian iconography, symbolises infinity, eternal recurrence and the union of opposites.
