When Ernst Ludwig Kirchner moved from Berlin to the area near Davos in the Canton of Graubünden, the world of the mountains found its way into his creative work and inspired the painter, graphic artist and sculptor to create numerous works. In particular, Stafelalp, located above Davos, served Kirchner as a model from 1918 to 1920 and was reflected in numerous drawings and paintings. We are pleased to offer you one of the museum-quality sheets from this period. With a typically rugged, Expressionist style, Ernst Ludwig Kirchner reports on the beauty of the Swiss mountain landscape. Similar preparatory studies for paintings from this period are in collections and museums of world renown, a collector's tip.
